#### Florence Nightingale: A Tribute

Florence Nightingale (12 May 1820 – 13 August 1910) was an English social reformer and statistician, and the founder of modern nursing. Nightingale came to prominence while serving as a manager of nurses trained by her during the Crimean War, where she organized the tending to wounded soldiers. She gave nursing a highly favorable reputation and became an icon of Victorian culture, especially in the persona of "The Lady with the Lamp" making rounds of wounded soldiers at night.

Nightingale laid the foundation of professional nursing with the establishment of her nursing school at St Thomas' Hospital in London. It was the first secular nursing school in the world, now part of King's College London. In recognition of her pioneering work in nursing, the Nightingale Pledge taken by new nurses, and the Florence Nightingale Medal, the highest international distinction a nurse can achieve, were named in her honor, and the annual International Nurses Day is celebrated around the world on her birthday 12 May. Her social reforms include improving healthcare for all sections of British society, advocating better hunger relief in India, helping to abolish laws that were over-harsh to women, and expanding the acceptable forms of female participation in the workforce.





#### Bhai Kanhaiya Ji: A Tribute

Bhai Kanhaiya ji (1648–1718) was a Sikh (disciple) of Guru Tegh Bahadur ji . Bhai Sahib was born in a Dhamman Khatri family of Sodhara near Wazirabad in Sialkot district (now in Pakistan). His father was a wealthy trader, but he himself being of a religious bent left home when he was still very young and roamed about with saddhus and ascetics in search of spiritual peace.



During the frequent sallies and skirmishes between the Sikhs and the enemy, Bhai Kanhaiya was often seen carrying a mashak (a sort of pouch used to carry water from one place to another), to serve water to anyone who was thirsty. He took upon the task of quenching the thirst of the wounded soldiers in the battle of Anandpur Sahib in 1704. He did this sewa with love and affection without any discrimination between the Guru's Sikh soldiers and the Mughal armies' soldiers. His act of compassion stirred up stern criticism amongst his fellow Sikhs. Bhai Kanhaiya Ji replied "Yes, my Guru, what they say is true. But Maharaj, I saw no Mughal or Sikh on the battlefield. I only saw human beings. they all have the same God's Spirit. OUR SIKH HEROES DESTROY ENEMIES BY KILLING THEM, BUT I WIN ENMITY BY GIVING THEM SERVICE."

#### **GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 1. Students must maintain strict discipline in the campus, including the hostel.
- 2. Late comers will not be allowed in class/will be marked absent.
- 3. Students have to attend all the classes- theory, practical, clinical training and field work, regularly. They also have to attend all the seminars, conferences, guest lectures, social and cultural activities, authorized by the institute.
- 4. Due to unavoidable circumstances, if any student want leave then he/she has to got sanction the leave on prescribed format.
- 5. A fine of Rs. 10 per lecture will be imposed for absent without information.
- 6. Students should wear proper uniform along with Identity card. The fine will be imposed for improper uniform or without I-Card.
- 7. Strict action shall be taken against the students found damaging or defacing the institution property /equipment in any form.
- 8. Students must maintain dignified behavior and use parliamentary and respectful language.
- 9. Strict action shall be taken against the students who will indulge in strikes and other illegal activities.
- 10. Use of intoxicants in any form is completely banned.
- 11. Students must maintain cleanliness in the building & surrounding.
- 12. Everybody must take special care to conserve water and electricity.
- 13. Use of mobiles is prohibited in academic block.
- 14. Students should not keep any valuable / jewellery etc. with them in college campus. College authorities will not be responsible for any loss of any belongings.

#### **For Clinical Area**

- 100% attendance should be required in clinical area.
- Student should wear proper uniform in clinical area including black shoes with laces, white shocks, ID card, proper bun with net.
- Student should carry pocket articles. Such as scissor, nail cutter, pen (red, blue, black), pocket diary, nurses dictionary, measuring tape, thermometer, stethoscope, B.P. apparatus, sanitizer etc.
- Student have to buy their own kit to carry required articles as prescribed by class teacher.
- No Mobile phone are allowed in academic block and Clinical areas.

# **Important Information**

- 1. Student should read notice board regularly to get information of imp. Dates.
- 2. Student must ensure to deposit all fee regularly, to avoid any inconvenience.
- 3. If any late fee deposit by student, penalty will be imposed as per rule.
- 4. Hostel Food charges must be ensure to deposit in advance, 15th date of every month is the last date after that only paid food will be served.
- 5. As per University norm security fee of Rs.25000 is required to be submitted at the time of admission. Original Document are kept with University/College till completion of the whole course. Student can receive Original certificates in lieu of security fee & blank chq.
- 6. If student left Course in between, He/she has to deposit fee of whole course. Fee once deposited will not be adjusted and returned in any case.
- 7. College transport is arranged on annual contract basis, Student cannot left transport service in between the session. Student have to deposit full year charges, if opted once.
- 8. Transport service can only provided for the route and area already in approach.
- 9. Hostel rooms are limited, student must ensure to stay for whole of the year and cannot left in between the session. If Student left the hostel, have to deposit full year charges.
- 10. During Clinical training and examination at other center or hospital, Hostler students need to pay charges for the use of College transportation.
- 11. Other Charges like Registration, counseling, clinical training, Exam fee, Books, Dress are not included in academic fee.
- 12. All Dues must be cleared to get Roll No. and also for posting of Clinical Training.
- 13. If student get any relief or relaxation in Tuition fee, College is authorized to recover that relief amount from any Govt. Scholarship scheme.

#### **Hostel Rules & Regulations:**

- 1. Students are directed to follow study hour strictly.
- 2. Main Gate will be locked at 7.00 PM. Student must enter in campus before 7.00 PM.
- 3. No hosteller is allowed to change room without approval and cannot shift furniture from one room to another room.
- 4. Student can only go out with Gate pass signed by parents whether for outing or to go home.
- 5. Stay home more than sanctioned leave are not allowed.
- 6. If students want to use their own cooler during summer, electricity charges will be charged extra in advance as prescribed.
- 7. No outsiders/Relatives/Parents are allowed to stay in the hostel.
- 8. Visiting hours (For authorized visitors only) are from 10AM-6PM (Saturday Sundays).
- 9. No cooking is allowed in hostel rooms. Room service of food is not allowed.
- 10. Hostellers are responsible for cleanliness of their rooms. Rooms will be inspected by faculty/ warden/authority at regular interval at any time.
- 11. Every hosteller should made entry in the departure register before leaving the hostel/campus.
- 12. All lights and fans must be switched off when leaving the room, otherwise fine of Rs. 500/will be charged.
- 13. Hostellers are not allowed to keep valuable, cash or gold jewelry in the hostel. Authorities will not be responsible for any loss.
- 14. Fixed Diet will be served with respect to the menu approved by the authorities.
- 15. No one is allowed to use abusive language in hostel.
- 16. Students are not allowed to conduct meetings/strikes in hostel. In any case any student is found guilty, disciplinary action will be taken.
- 17. Ragging is strictly forbidden in hostel as well as in college campus.
- 18. Physical presence of student is must at time of hostel attendance.
- 19. No electric appliance like heater, iron, TV, electric rod, are allowed in room. If found guilty the concerned hosteller will be fined Rs. 1000/-.
- 20. Every student should share the responsibility to keep the common room, bathroom, toilets and washrooms clean.
- 21. Hostellers should submit passport size photographs of any three relatives for making identity cards. Only those persons will be allowed to meet. Only Blood relation/family members are allowed to meet.

22. Hostel stay is compulsory for all students as per University norm. Hostel to be opt for full session only. Student cannot left hostel in between the session.

### **RAGGING**

#### What is Ragging?

Ragging refers to an act that violates the dignity of a person. There have been many complaints of physical and psychological injury due to ragging in colleges and educational institutions.

It has been turned to a nightmare to students and their guardians at the time of admission to Engineering, Polytechnic and Medical/nursing colleges.

## **Objectives of Anti-Ragging Programme**

- To make colleges "A Ragging Free Zone" by weeding out ragging in all forms.
- To absolutely prohibit ragging within or outside the college campus.
- To prevent the occurrence of ragging by following anti-ragging measures in the institution.
- To punish those who indulge in ragging as per guidelines.

#### The Anti-Ragging punishment will vary from:-

- Imprisonment ( As it's a Criminal Offence )
- Permanent expulsion from the institution/ Hostel
- Suspension from the institution/ Hostel
- Fine with public apology.

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# IMPORTANT RULES BY GOVT. OF PUNJAB & BABA FARID UNIVERSITY PROSPECTUS AVAILABLE ON UNIVERSITY WEBSITE

- As per notification of Govt of Punjab, Department of Medical Education and Research (Health-III Branch)-No-11/68/2019=5HB-III/5887 dated 01-10-2020. Fee should be increased annually in Government and Private both institutions by 5% for five years for subsequent batches and fee be reviewed again after 5 years, with rounding off to nearest hundred
- Tuition fee for 'one year' shall be paid to Registrar, Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot.
- iii) If candidate is shifted from one College to another in the subsequent Counselling, the fee shall be refunded / adjusted after completion of the admission process. The University shall refund / adjust the fee within 30 days.
- iv) The fee will be payable on 'annual '.basis'. The colleges will not insist for deposit of fee of the entire course in advance.
- (b) Hostel fee and security advance (Annual and provisional) for private institutes. Hostel fee for University Constituents Colleges shall be in terms of Punjab Government letter no-7/107/2012-5553/209 dated 11-02-2015.
- a. Non Air Conditioned Independent Room: Rs.16,500/- per year for the First year (Maximum) for single bedroom. This fee may be hiked by maximum upto 5% for each subsequent year.
- Special Room (Attached bathroom and AC). Rs.26,400/- per year (Maximum). This fee may be hiked by maximum upto 10% for each subsequent year.
- Security Advance Rs.27,500/- or its equivalent (refundable in the shape of demand draft.)
- d. Mess charges- Actual and to be managed by the students.
- These charges are exclusive of electricity and water charges but inclusive of every other charge. All charges shall be levied from students on six monthly basis.

# 14. (A) Reservation in Government Nursing Colleges :

The reservation for the State quota seats in Government Institutes in various categories for admission to the Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing course in Government Nursing Colleges shall be as under:

(i)	Scheduled Castes	25%
(ii)	Backward Classes	10%
(iii)	Backward Area/ Border Area (1% each)	2%
(iv)	Physically Disabled	594

 The Reservation of Physically Challenged persons shall be as per the provision of Right of Persons with Disability Act 2016

Successful handicapped candidates must appear before the Medical Board at Guru Gobind Singh Medical College, Faridkot on specified date notified by the BFUHS, Faridkot before counselling

- Seats remaining vacant under any of the reserve category shall be transferred to the General Category
- j) For students admitted through online counseling, fee shall be deposited as prescribed by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot after verification of documents. For students admitted through physical counseling, fee shall be deposited through Bank Demand Draft only.
- (k) If candidate surrender the seat in-between during the course, then candidate is liable to pay full fee for entire course.
- 21. The State Government reserves the right to amend any clause and procedure for admission.
- 22. In case of any doubt, the Administrative Secretary, Department of Medical Education & Research, Government of Punjab may issue clarification which will have force of the policy
- 23. For any dispute arising out of this notification or of the admissions under this notification, the Administrative Secretary, Department of Medical Education & Research, Government of Punjab shall be competent to resolve whose decisions shall be final.
- 24. This notification supersedes all the notifications for admission to Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing Course in the State, issued earlier.


